The Studies of the Region courses need to be approved by the <u>UNSW Business School Student Centre.</u> To proceed on the Commerce Overseas Program (COP) students must have achieved satisfactory academic progress in their first and second years of study and must fulfil the requirements of the University's Exchange Program.
Free Electives or Second major or Commerce minor	Account for 48-54UOC (8-9 courses). Students are free to use these UOC to complete courses from any Faculty however they need to be mindful of the program limit on Level 1 courses (84UOC) when making their selection. Ways to use these UOC include: completing a range of courses across different Faculties; completing a second business major or commerce minor; expanding the International Studies courses into a major or minor. Courses cannot double count in two majors.
