Terminology	Definition
Introductory First Year Business Core Courses	Students must complete 30UOC (5 courses) of Introductory First Year Business Core Courses.
Compulsory Information Systems Core Courses	Students must complete 72UOC (12 courses) of level 1, 2 and 3 Information Systems Core Courses.
Information Systems Electives	Students must complete 12UOC (2 courses) of Information Systems electives to focus on skills in data analytics, programming and/or information systems in organisations.
Mandatory Work Integrated Learning (WIL) Course	Students must complete at least 6UOC (1 course) in Work Integrated Learning (WIL) course within their program.
Free Electives	Students must complete 12 UOC of Free electives. These courses can be offered by any faculty but cannot be GEN coded.
